Today's gospel launches Jesus on his public ministry. He has come to proclaim the reign of God. 'Repent and believe the Good News'. To assist him in this task, he calls some fishermen to leave their nets and follow him.

I remember on one occasion coming across a skit, written in the form of a letter, directed to Jesus of Nazareth and from a firm called the Jordon Management Consultants:

'Dear Sir,

Thank you for submitting the character profiles of the twelve men you have picked for management positions in your new organisation. All of them have now taken part in our various assessment skills; we have not only run the tests through our computer, but we have also arranged personal interviews for each of them with our psychologists and vocational consultants.
