Beragh Parish Cemeteries

The Parish Cemeteries Committee (in consultation with the Parish Finance and Pastoral Committees) have arranged a survey of each of the Parish Cemeteries.

Draft surveys are available to view in each of the Parish Churches. Parishioners are asked to check the details of their family plots and to use the forms provided to make any amendments before the end of January.

Parishioners are also requested to identify any graves that remain unmarked; it is intended to use for burial, any areas that are not identified as graves.

This forms part of the review of Cemetery regulations which will be announced to coincide with the completion of the survey.
