Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

In today's gospel different groups of people approach John the Baptist and they each ask a similar question: "What must we do?" The common thread in answer to all his questioners was to encourage them to be other-centred rather than self-centred.

John is uncompromising and his reply to each group relates very directly to their way of life and is very specific in terms of how they should behave. Some were told to be generous, to clothe those in need and to provide food for the hungry; the tax collectors were told that they should not extort more money than was due; to abandon the way of deceit and fraud; the soldiers were told that they should not accuse people in the wrong.

If you could imagine yourself going up to John and asking that question "What must I do?" what do you think his answer might be? Or supposing you were to take five minutes today to sit quietly with that question.... to ponder the question in peace and silence. It might be interesting to reflect on what comes to mind. In doing an exercise like this it can be helpful, beforehand, to whisper a prayer to the Holy Spirit for enlightenment and guidance. "What must I do?"

In trying to answer the question for myself I will probably find much more than all the things I've forgotten to do for Christmas. "What must I do?" is intended to be a reflective question that relates to my responsibilities as a follower of Jesus Christ.

"God our Father, help us prepare the manger of our hearts for the coming of Christ. As we listen to John the Baptist calling us to prepare the way of the Lord and to make straight his path, we ask for clarity and insight. Reveal to us our real sins: the flaws, the hurts and the resentments that we harbour in our hearts. Make us aware of all negligence and indifference that stunts our commitment as followers of Christ. Help us to realise the impact our selfish behaviour can have on other people. Give us the courage to entrust our past to your mercy and to commend our future to your providence. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen".

Covid 19 Wakes and Funerals

When a person has died as a result of Covid 19, new regulations governing arrangements for wakes and funerals have come into effect from September 2021. Where there is a negligible risk of transmitting the Covid 19 infection, the remains of the deceased are allowed to be taken home and viewing is permitted. They can also be brought to the church for the funeral Mass. However, the regulations regarding numbers permitted to gather, social distancing, hand hygiene and face coverings must be observed. Anyone who has had a positive Covid 19 test result or anyone who is symptomatic should not attend.

Week-end Masses

I am aware that some people in the parish are quite annoyed there is no Mass in St Malachy's, Seskinore on Sunday and no Mass in St Patrick's, Drumduff on Saturday evening, as was the practice in recent years. I share their disappointment, but unfortunately the situation is outside my control. I would love to be able to reinstate the arrangements we had prior to Covid-19. However, the current regulations regarding places of worship are determined, not by numbers in attendance, but by capacity. It is the responsibility of the parish to ensure that the building can safely accommodate people by ensuring the stipulated social distancing, in addition to the other protocols regarding signage, ventilation, and sanitisation etc. Given the size of Seskinore and Drumduff churches, it is not possible to have public week-end Masses until the Health Authorities and the Executive relax the present guidelines.

Covid-19

While the Executive has decided to ease the restriction of face coverings in places of worship, Church leaders are encouraging people to continue to use them as a precautionary measure against the spread of infection.
